**PRO BONO PARTNERSHIPS**

**Pro Bono Clinics**

Faculty:

- TTU law school faculty co-sponsor pro bono clinics held by Legal Aid of Northwest Texas Equal Justice Volunteer Program once a year – twice a month
- Provide the necessary faculty volunteers to staff clinics
- Accept cases and/or provide consultation

Clinical Courses

- Clinic faculty require students to volunteer at two or more pro bono clinics sponsored by Legal Aid of Northwest Texas as part of their course assignment
- Cases accepted for the civil clinic and family law counseling clinic are referrals from Legal Aid of Northwest Texas

Volunteer Law Students Association

- Provide volunteers to assist at pro bono clinics
- Clinical Program staff or EJVP Coordinator provide orientation to students

**Wills Project**

- Partnership between Civil Clinic, Legal Aid of Northwest Texas, and the Wills and Trusts class
- Four (4) clinics are scheduled throughout the community during the Fall Semester
- Legal Aid of Northwest Texas EJVP Coordinator promotes the clinics through PSA's to radio, television, and newspapers, as well as, prepares and distributes flyers to social service agencies, community centers, etc. EJVP Coordinator schedules the client appointments for the clinics
- 132-134 students draft questionnaires, conduct interviews, draft wills, and oversee execution of wills. Students work in groups of four.
- Civil clinic faculty member supervises students until the cases are completed
