* Idaho Rule of Professional Conduct 6.1:

Every lawyer has a professional responsibility to provide legal services to those unable to pay. A lawyer should aspire to render at least (50) hours of pro bono public legal services per year to persons of limited means or to charitable, religious, civic, community, governmental and education organizations.
