PSLawNet is the most efficient way to reach thousands of law students and attorneys with just one job or volunteer posting. And the service is entirely FREE to public sector employers.

What is PSLawNet?

The Public Service Law Network (PSLawNet) is an online database connecting law students and lawyers with thousands of listings for public interest opportunities (internships, fellowships, full-time positions, etc). Over 180 law schools subscribe to PSLawNet, providing their current students and alumni with access to our database. PSLawNet acts as a virtual bulletin board where public interest and government employers can use our database to post information about their organization as well as any job opportunities they want to advertise.

How do Employer Organizations Post Information on PSLawNet?

Organizations may post information on PSLawNet very simply and **at no cost**. We encourage you to take advantage of this free resource by registering directly at www.pslawnet.org. Simply select the "Getting Started" link and go from there. You will be prompted to enter basic organizational information about your office. Once your organization is registered on PSLawNet, you may post and edit job opportunities at any time. **Or you may email opportunities to us at pslawnet@nalp.org and we will post them for you.**

What Kinds of Employer Organizations Post Info on PSLawNet?

PSLawNet includes profiles and opportunity postings for over 11,000 organizations, including legal aid, public defender, prosecutor, and other public interest offices, as well as government agencies (local/state/federal) and law firms with public interest practices.

A New PSLawNet is on the Horizon!

A new version of PSLawNet will debut August 2008. New employer functions include:

- The ability to search all organizational profiles and job opportunities
- Full preview and edit functions for all of your organization's job postings
- The option to have job seekers apply directly through PSLawNet in response to your job postings
