APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS BY STATE

Listed below are the special CLE credit requirements

Alabama: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

<u>Alaska</u>: Alaska Bar members may claim credit for attendance at CLE programs offered in or from other jurisdictions if the program has been accredited by another MCLE jurisdiction. Attorneys can submit the class with the form they fill out each year. **Please Note:** Attorneys may only report ONCE per calendar year. Once their MCLE reporting form is submitted it cannot be amended.

<u>Arizona:</u> Attorneys are to use their own discretion to determine if a seminar meets CLE requirements and are responsible for reporting their own hours to the bar at the end of each year.

Arkansas: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

<u>California</u>: All California attorneys <u>are required to sign in</u> once for NLADA's records. Also fill out the California certificate of attendance to keep for your records. Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours. **Please note:** California has a reciprocal agreement with many other jurisdictions. Attorneys may use the reciprocal approval letter from **Indiana** and must maintain it in their records for a minimum of 4 years. **Please Note:** Your hours will not show up on your CLE record. Please keep your Certification of Attendance and submit the form during the audit.

<u>Colorado:</u> Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours. Colorado attorneys and judges may report CLE Credits earned at this seminar by logging into the Online CLE Transcript. You can access the online entry of Affidavits by visiting http://www.cletrack.com. Click on CLE Transcripts, login and select Enter Online Affidavits.

Connecticut: Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours. Attorneys certify completion of MCLE credits on the annual attorney registration form.

<u>Delaware:</u> All Delaware attorneys <u>are required to sign in at each session</u> they attend for NLADA's records. Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

<u>Florida:</u> Attorneys report their hours online at <u>www.floridabar.org</u>. Submit your completed Certification of Attendance form to NLADA for our records.

[ONSITE] Georgia: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing. Attorneys seeking CLE credit in the State of Georgia and attorneys will be invoiced by NLADA \$4.00 for each credit hour sought.

<u>Hawai'i:</u> Hawaii has a reciprocal agreement with many other jurisdictions. Attorneys may use the reciprocal approval letter from **Indiana** and must apply directly with to the Hawaii State Bar Association. Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours on the annual attorney registration form.

<u>Idaho:</u> Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing. Attorneys must also submit a self-verification that they attended the course.

[ONSITE] Illinois: All Illinois attorneys <u>are required to sign in</u> at each session they attend. Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing. NLADA will pay \$18 for course credit.

Indiana: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

<u>Iowa:</u> Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours.

Kansas: Submit your completed Certification of Attendance form to NLADA for our records.

[ONSITE] Kentucky: Attorney's must submit their attendance through the Member CLE Portal at www.kybar.org. Return this form with the completed NLADA Certification of Attendance form to registration.

Louisiana: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

Maine: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

Maryland: No CLE credits required.

Massachusetts: No CLE credits required.

Michigan: No CLE credits required.

Minnesota: Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours.

<u>Mississippi:</u> Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing. **Please Note**: Attorneys pay \$2 dollars per hour to Mississippi.

Missouri: Using the course ID, Attorneys are required to file an Annual Report of Compliance, Form 1, with the Missouri Bar by July 31.

[ONSITE] Montana: Attorneys MUST complete a MT CLE Credit Request Form, and return it with the completed NLADA Certification of Attendance form directly to MT. Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours.

Nebraska: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

Nevada: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing, later affirming attendance.

New Hampshire: Attorneys self-report on MCLE website.

New Jersey: Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours.

[ONSITE] New Mexico: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing. NLADA will invoice each NM attorney \$22.00 for CLE hours sought.

<u>New York:</u> Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours. New York has a reciprocal agreement with 34 other jurisdictions. Attorneys may pick up verification of approval in one of the jurisdictions at the registration desk and must maintain it in their records for a minimum of 4 years. For this conference, NY attorneys can use the Oklahoma approval letter. Your hours will not show up on your CLE record. Please keep your Certification of Attendance in a safe place and submit it during the audit.

[ONSITE] North Carolina: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing; North Carolina State Board bills individual attendees for filing fees (\$3.50 per credit hour) at a later date.

North Dakota: Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours.

Ohio: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

<u>Oklahoma:</u> All Oklahoma attorneys <u>are required to sign in once each morning and once each afternoon</u> for NLADA's records. Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

Oregon: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

[ONSITE] Pennsylvania: Attorneys should submit a copy of the Pennsylvania Credit Request Form and a copy of the NLADA Certificate of Attendance along with a check, made payable to PACLE, for \$1.50 per credit hour.

Puerto Rico: Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours.

Rhode Island: Attorneys must **apply directly** to the Rhode Island Bar.

South Carolina: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

South Dakota: No CLE credits required.

[ONSITE] Tennessee: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing. Attach payment of \$1.00 for each credit hour sought.

[ONSITE] Texas: Attorneys **MUST attach a payment for \$10,** along with a completed Certification of Attendance form to NLADA for filing.

[ONSITE] Utah: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing. Attorneys must submit to **\$15.00 for attendance.**

Vermont: Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours.

<u>Virgin Islands:</u> Attorneys maintain their own records and report their own hours.

<u>Virginia</u>: Attorneys must <u>apply directly</u> to the Virginia Bar. They should obtain the Application for Course Approval (Form 4), complete an NLADA Certification of Attendance form, attach a copy of the agenda that highlights the sessions you attended, and include 2-3 pages of the course materials for each session you attended.

Washington: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.

West Virginia: Attorneys will submit their completed Certification of Attendance forms to NLADA for filing.
