CIVIL PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The National Legal Aid & Defender Association (NLADA) Civil Legal Services Division (CLS) works to ensure the existence of high quality, well-funded civil legal aid systems throughout the country. Membership in NLADA shows your support for the equal justice community and provides access to invaluable resources for legal aid professionals. Your dues make possible the CLS accomplishments listed below:

- Trained over 2,000 legal aid advocates through conferences and remote learning programs. Substantive legal issues, access to increased federal funding, and methods of improving program administration and advocacy were covered through in-depth training.
- Conducted congressional advocacy to increase funding for the Legal Services Corporation (LSC) and partnered with the Department of Justice to increase non-LSC federal funding.
- Organized the national response to ensure that legal aid was included in the Attorney Generals' settlements in home mortgage lending. Consequently, over \$32 million has been allocated to legal assistance funding for homeowners facing eviction.
- Established a statewide veterans' coalition in North Carolina through the Public-Private Action (PPA) initiative that can serve as a model for similar initiatives across the nation.
- Commissioned a state-of-the-art online resource (<u>www.legalaidresearch.org</u>) facilitating public access to the most recent civil legal aid research and data. Established a similar website (<u>www.legalaidresources.org</u>) to highlight the availability of federal funding for civil legal assistance.
- Advanced regulatory changes that included the eligibility of human trafficking victims and immigrant victims of abuse under LSC regulations.
- Developed a strategic framework for legal aid programs that promote racial equity through advocacy efforts.
- Provided in-depth, hands-on racial equity training and technical assistance to four statewide entities.
- Advocated successfully with a number of federal agencies to adopt procedures protecting the attorney-client relationship when reporting on federal grant funding.
- Collaborated with the National Center for Medical-Legal Partnership (NCMLP) to select 24 fellows for training at NLADA conferences and through webinars to lead the expansion of the medical-legal partnership model in underserved regions of the country.

NLADA UPDATE AND FEDERAL REGULATORY MEMOS:

The *NLADA UPDATE*, delivered electronically twice a month, provides critical, in-depth information and analyses on activities in Congress and at the Legal Services Corporation (LSC), as well as reporting on many critical issues and developments relevant to your program's work. Periodic NLADA Federal Regulatory memos provide in-depth analysis to legal aid programs regarding compliance with complex, federal regulatory requirements. Subscriptions to these enhanced services allow NLADA staff to provide the detailed coverage necessary to monitor and report on important issues regarding the Legal Services Corporation and other federal agencies.

NLADA Program Membership is a prerequisite to subscribe. The cost of an annual subscription to *NLADA UPDATE* and Federal Regulatory memos is \$1,000. To subscribe, please mark the box on the membership application/renewal form and include payment with your dues renewal.
